This role will also assist with corporate governance and managing financial crime and data protection risks of the business.

Requirements and Attributes

- Bachelor's degree and above preferred, or strong hands-on experience;
- 4 to 6 years of demonstrated commercial project experience and experience in legal and compliance training or background is a strong plus. Willingness to work in a team environment, to learn, contribute inputs and a passion for improving the business is paramount;
