Procurement brief:

Videography and photography services for Ba Lai Water Project

Pre- and post-production support required for the filming project in Ba Lai District, Ben Tre Province, Vietnam; April / May 2024

1. Introduction

InfraCo Asia is part of the Private Infrastructure Development Group (PIDG). InfraCo Asia's mission is to catalyse private sector investments needed to bridge the infrastructure gap in Asia's emerging and frontier markets. It does this by deploying funding and expertise to de-risk the early-stage development of socially responsible and sustainable infrastructure projects that make a lasting impact on people and economies, in alignment with the UN's Sustainable Development Goals.

InfraCo Asia is co-developing a portfolio of water supply projects with Singapore-listed company Darco Water Technologies. Through the Vietnam Portfolio of Potable Water Supply Projects, InfraCo Asia aims to increase private sector participation in water supply projects in Vietnam to help meet its water supply and sanitation-related development goals, including universal access to safe drinking water by 2030. The Vietnam Portfolio of Potable Water Supply Projects involves the implementation of water distribution systems (or retail water supply plants) in semi-rural regions of Vietnam.

We are looking to create a video that shows the positive impact the first project – the Ba Lai Water Treatment Plant – has had on the communities it serves, and highlight the role of InfraCo Asia and PIDG in bringing the project to life. We would like to tell this story through high-quality film and photography production, captured in Vietnam's Ba Lai province in <u>April / May 2024</u> (tentative dates to be proposed by the film crew with the proposal submitted).

2. Key objectives

Subject to the footage gathered, we would anticipate outputs of:

- 1 video of about 3 minutes at 4K, 1080 and 720 resolutions in two formats: With subtitles, without subtitles
- The videos should include shots of people, technology, work site and drone footage. The audio should be clear for interviews in office and outdoor settings.
- Option to charge per additional 15s of video length should be quoted
- All raw footage provided in high-quality format for archival and future use
- Selection of high-resolution photographs of interviewees as well as the facility

Translation and subtitling in English

Filming to include pre- and post-production support, editing and around travel within Ba Lai district. Examples of our past videos can be found here: InfraCo Asia (vimeo.com)

Here are some possible topics that can be integrated into the video, we are excited to hear your perspective and ideas to shape the narrative as well:

1. Water projects are known to be difficult. In many parts of Asia, treated water is costly and public water supply is lacking, but there is little incentive for private parties to invest without commercial returns.

We have successfully launched this water treatment facility with our partner, Ba Lai Water Technologies, Singapore, through bridging the funding gap and providing grants to provide discounted water rates to users. We would like to capture the impact that this plant is having on the end users in our video, while hinting at the challenges that were overcome.

a) Person-in-focus 1: InfraCo Asia (IAs) staff, who has been involved from project inception and can speak about it from various angles: technical and development-related challenges, industry relevance, PIDG goals etc.
Possible footage to capture: IAs staff at the plant, possible footage of people laying pipeline (safety signages on site, employees are wearing neat and clean Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), use of earmuff/ear plugs in noisy pump area, machine and equipment are in reasonably good condition).

2. Impact on people

- a) Person-in-focus 2: Ba Lai Water project sales rep. Potential topics to cover include their view on the current water supply situation in the province, and reflections on customers' needs and challenges and how the project addresses them, and any anecdotes about interactions with customers.

 Footage to capture: Sales rep interacting with the local community
- b) Person-in-focus 3: Local community person, with an impact on their personal life Footage to capture: Unhealthy conditions of rivulets and streams, interview with a local person about their need for clean water impacting their health and well-being. A person who now has more convenience in their daily life as a result of the water supply could also be considered.
- c) Person-in-focus 4: Local community person, with an impact on their business Footage to capture: The owner of a local cowshed could be a potential interviewee. This person could speak about how access to clean water is improving their livestock health and allowing them greater productivity from freed up time not treating water themselves.

Other footage to consider:

- Staff in Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) working on the projects
- Details of installations focus on Health and Safety measures, technical knowledge and speed of installation.
- Still photography of individuals we interview and of the installations and location(s)
- Drone footage to establish the scale and rural nature of the landscape.

3. Photography

Photos should be taken during the shoot of the people being interviewed within their work's context. Photos also need to be taken of the project sites and the technology used.

4. Consent

All people captured in the interviews and photographs should give their consent by signing the consent form. InfraCo Asia will supply these.

5. Milestones

The following milestones are expected to be the sequence of events until job completion. Please feel free to suggest a different process, but in a similar format if you wish.
